



# RULES FOR VISITORS

## ENGIS SITE

- As a visitor, you should report to the gatekeeper's lodge at the site entrance, where you will be issued with a **badge**. You must wear it, ensuring that it is clearly visible, throughout your visit.
- You will be welcomed by a Prayon representative, who will **stay with you** throughout your visit.
- You must wear appropriate **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)** for the areas you will be visiting.

If you are visiting production sites and Research Department pilot areas, you should be wearing the following **before your enter**:



- If you are **walking** along the roads within the **production areas**, we would ask you to wear, at the very least, a **hard hat, safety goggles, closed shoes** (no high-heeled shoes) and **clothes that cover your entire body** (no shorts, no skirts).
  - You **do not need to wear any PPE** if you are only visiting the **administrative offices** at the site entrance and outside the production areas.
  - Do not hesitate to request information from your Prayon contact person before your visit – your contact will give you additional information about the required equipment.
- You must **respect the rules of the road** throughout the site.
  - You must park your vehicle in one of the **official car parks**.
  - **Priority for rail vehicles**: you must comply with any signals when crossing the rails.
  - **Smoking is strictly prohibited** outside the designated smoking areas.
  - You must not take **photos** or **film** on the site unless you have been given permission to do so.
