



RULES FOR VISITORS

LES ROCHES SITE

- As a visitor, you should report to the gatekeeper's lodge at the site entrance, where you will be issued with a **badge**. You must wear it throughout your visit.
- You will be welcomed by a Prayon representative, who will **stay with you** throughout your visit.
- You must wear appropriate **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)** for the areas you will be visiting.
 - When you enter the site, the gatekeeper will give you an **evacuation mask**, which you must keep fastened to your belt throughout your visit.
 - If you are visiting production sites, you should be **wearing the following** before you enter:



- You **do not need to wear any PPE, other than the evacuation mask**, if you are only visiting the **offices** outside the production areas. You must use the **green areas**.
 - Do not hesitate to request information from your Prayon contact person before your visit – your contact will give you additional information about the required equipment.
- You must **respect the rules of the road** throughout the site.
 - You must park your vehicle in one of the **official car parks**.
 - **Priority for rail vehicles**: you must comply with any signals when crossing the rails.
 - **Smoking is strictly prohibited** outside the designated smoking areas.
 - You must not take **photos or film** on the site unless you have been given permission to do so.
